## **Terms & Conditions Of Entry: Potters Grand Prix**

- 1) Entry into this tournament is only granted to the players whose names appear on the entry form and is not transferable to other persons.
- 2) A team's entry is only confirmed when a completed entry form accompanied by full payment of the entry fee (as cleared funds) has been received by The Short Mat Players Tour Ltd (SMPT).
- 3) A team may cancel their entry at any time. The SMPT will only refund the entry fee paid (less £1 per player to cover admin charges incurred by SMPT), providing all of the following three criteria are met:
  - a) Written notice of the cancellation is emailed to <a href="info@shortmatplayerstour.com">info@shortmatplayerstour.com</a> or posted to Short Mat Players Tour Ltd, Burwood, 45 Priory Road, Bicknacre, Chelmsford, Essex, CM3 4EY.
  - b) The written notice of cancellation is received by SMPT no later than 28 days prior to the start of the tournament.
  - c) The event is full, as per the advertised capacity on the relevant tournament page on the SMPT website, when the draw is done.
- 4) Any team wishing to cancel less than 28 days prior to the start of the tournament will not be eligible for a refund of their entry fee.
- 5) All entrants under the age of 18 at the start of the tournament must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. There is no allocation of discounted children's entries for Under 18s at this event.
