Terms & Conditions Of Entry: Welsh Grand Prix 2 Bowl Pairs

- 1) Entry into this tournament is only granted to the players whose names appear on the entry form and is not transferable to other persons.
- 2) A team's entry is only confirmed when a completed entry form accompanied by full payment of the entry fee (as cleared funds) has been received by The Short Mat Players Tour Ltd (SMPT).
- 3) A team may cancel their entry at any time. The SMPT will only refund the entry fee paid (less £1 per player to cover admin charges incurred by SMPT), providing all of the following three criteria are met:
 - a) Written notice of the cancellation is emailed to info@shortmatplayerstour.com or posted to Short Mat Players Tour Ltd, Burwood, 45 Priory Road, Bicknacre, Chelmsford, Essex, CM3 4EY.
 - b) The written notice of cancellation is received by SMPT no later than 14 days prior to the start of the tournament.
 - c) The event is full, as per the advertised capacity on the relevant tournament page on the SMPT website, when entries close.
- 4) Any team wishing to cancel less than 14 days prior to the start of the tournament will not be eligible for a refund of their entry fee.
- 5) All entrants under the age of 18 at the start of the tournament must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. There is no allocation of 'free' under 18 entries for this event.
- 6) Players are expected to comply with the event rules of play and the SMPT code of conduct: www.shortmatplayerstour.com/code-of-conduct/
- 7) All teams in SMPT events will be drawn into groups, as per the 'Format' information on the 'Tournament' page of the website, however SMPT cannot be held responsible for any team withdrawals after the draw has been made. Therefore SMPT cannot guarantee that a set number of group games will be played, because the number of games in any group might be reduced due to late withdrawals (if replacements are not found) or other circumstances including lateness, illness and other absences.
- 8) The event 'Format' is subject to entries and may change. All teams will be informed of any change at the earliest possible opportunity.
- 9) Prize money stated for the tournament is strictly subject to entries. It may be paid out either in pounds sterling, the equivalent amount of local currency or in the form of vouchers. The SMPT reserves the right to increase or decrease this amount without notice. All teams will be informed of any change at the earliest possible opportunity.
- 10) Entry into a SMPT event is a privilege and not a right. As such, SMPT reserves the right to refuse any team or player's entry. If an entry is refused, SMPT will notify the team or player at the earliest opportunity (usually within 7 days from receipt of the entry) and a full refund of the entry fee will then be processed.
- 11) The SMPT reserves the right to cancel the event at any time. All teams will be informed at the earliest opportunity and will receive a full refund of their entry fee. The SMPT will not be liable for any losses due to an event being cancelled.
